Sports Venues

Regulations Archery

The United World Games Archery Tournament will be held according to the official rules of the World Archery, the World Archery Europe and the Austrian Archery Federation.

Most Important Rule - FAIR PLAY

It should be needless to say, but we expect fair play from all teams! Please respect your opponents as well as the decisions of the referees and try to play as fair as possible.

1. Bow Divisions and Age Groups

Bow Divisions:

Recurve, Compound, Barebow, Longbow and Instinctive Bow

Age Groups:

children I (m/w) - 10 - 12 years,
children II (m/w) - 13 - 14 years,
cadets (m/w) - 15 - 17 years,
juniors (m/w) - 18 - 20 years

The due date for all age groups is the 01.01. (according to the WA-Rules).

Mixed:

A mixed team is composed of one male and one female athlete. Both must shoot the same bow division and distance onto the same target. Athletes are allowed to compete in a mixed team for another club.

2. ID Checks

The ID (date of birth) of the athletes will be checked at the equipment inspection on Friday. The player's passports or IDs must be brought along at the first day of competition (Friday). Athletes have to carry the accreditation, which will be handed out at the sports facility, all the time.

A violation results in an automatic disqualification of the athlete, who also loses the right to compete in the mixed team competition.

3. Individual: Qualification and Elimination

The qualification in the different bow divisions and age groups will be shot as follows:

Recurve - 122cm target face

juniors - 2x36 arrows - 70m

cadets - 2x36 arrows - 60m

children II - 2x36 arrows - 40m

children I - 2x36 arrows - 30m

Compound - 80cm target face (10-5)

juniors - 2x36 arrows - 50m

cadets - 2x36 arrows - 50m

children II - 2x36 arrows - 40m

children I - 2x36 arrows - 30m

Barebow - 122cm target face

juniors - 2x36 arrows - 40m

cadets - 2x36 arrows - 40m

children II - 2x36 arrows - 30m

children I - 2x36 arrows - 30m

We will have elimination rounds and finals for all bow divisions and age groups according to the WA rules, if there are more than four people in this division. It is our goal that all archers can shoot in the elimination rounds.

4. Mixed Team

A mixed team is composed of one male and one female athlete. Both must shoot the same bow division and distance onto the same target. Athletes are allowed to compete in a mixed team for another club.

The ranking of the mixed teams depends on the results of the archers, who are shooting together.

The elimination rounds will be held according to the WA-Rules.

5. Dress Regulations and Etiquette

We want to point out that the athletes have to wear sportswear or white clothes. The sports facility can only be entered with the accreditation. It is not allowed to bring any food or drinks into the sports facility.

Exception: PET bottles

Smoking is prohibited in all sport facilities!

6. Jury of Appeal

The tournament jury consists of 3 people who handle any possible complaints, protests and disqualifications. Protests must be reported to the jury (head-judge) by the responsible coach before the next part of the competition starts. The fee for the protest is € 100,- and will be refunded in case the protest was accepted.

8. Insurance, Disclaimer & Theft

The participants are not insured! It is up to the responsible authorities and coaches of each team to make sure that their archers and all the participants are insured for the days of the tournament during the United World Games. The organizers do not assume any kind of liability in case of illness, accidents or theft.

With his participation, the athlete accepts the disclaimer of warranty for any kind of damage. No claims can be asserted against the organizing committee, the event sponsors, the community of Klagenfurt, real owners or their representatives regarding damage or injuries. Every athlete has to make sure that he is fully physically capable of participating without any medical objections.

For all archers: Do not leave any valuable things and/or expensive clothing and/or shoes in the locker rooms.

9. Final Remark

We want to point out that doping tests (including alcohol checks) can be conducted by NADA in WA and Austrian Archery Federation registered competitions. Please read the information on the Austrian Archery Federation-Homepage or on www.nada.at. The athlete is responsible for the doping issue. If there is a positive doping result, the athlete has to bear the full costs. All rules according to World Archery and the competition specifications of the Austrian Archery Federation.

The organizers of the United World Games consider it as an obligation for each participant and team leader to know all the issues mentioned in these regulations.

IMPORTANT: In emergencies and during the night-time the emergency number 144 must be called. Please also note that if an injured athlete has to be transported to the hospital with an ambulance, a coach of the affected team must always go with him.
