Regulations Beach-Volleyball

All matches will be played according to the rules of the game laid down by the Fédération Internationale de Volleyball FIVB. Except the following special rule which is valid for the United World Games.

Most Important Rule - FAIR PLAY

It should be needless to say but we expect fair play from all teams! Please respect your opponents as well as the decisions of the referees and try to play as fair as possible.

1. Age Groups

Male and female:

Categories	Deadline	Field Size Number of Players
U 19	Born on 01.01.2000 and younger	8 x 8 m 2 vs. 2 *
U 17	Born on 01.01.2002 and younger	8 x 8 m 2 vs. 2 *
U 15	Born on 01.01.2004 and younger	8 x 8 m 2 vs. 2 *

* Since there may be an odd number of players in participating groups, 3-player teams are allowed, however only 2 allowed on the field.

2. Squad list & ID checks

Every player is only allowed to be part of one team. At the request of the tournament organizers identity cards / passport must be presented. **ID cards of the players have to be brought to all games.**

3. Match Duration and allocation of points

The game mode still depends on the number of registered teams in each category. Planned are group games to guarantee each team a minimum of three games. The matches are played to two won sets, with at least 2 points difference, whereby one set is played until 15 to avoid large delays. Every game won gives 2 points. If there is equality of points at the end of the group phase, the sets won decide. With equality in sets, the direct encounter counts. If several teams have the same number of points as well as the same amount of sets won, the point quotient counts. Should this be the same, the lot decides. The final matches are then played after international rules, with two won sets up to 21 (third set to 15).

Walk over (W.O.)

A team that fails to present itself on the court without any reported valid reason (decision if valid is made by the tournament committee) automatically loses the match 0:2 (0:15/21, 0:15/21). In case of disqualification all the matches played so far will be null and void. Delayed teams will be waited for a **maximum of 10 minutes**. No exception will be made.

With nonappearance of a team the remaining teams in the group continue playing as planned in her qualifying round phase, except the group is changed afterwards by the tournament management.

4. Important

- One Time Out per set is permitted, but there will be no technical time outs.
- Coaching between rallies and in time-outs is permitted.
- There will be no referees.
- The losing team has to be the referee for the next match which is played on that court.

5. Height of the net

U15 girls	2,15 meters
U17 girls	2,20 meters
U19 girls	2,24 meters
U15 boys	2,30 meters
U17 boys	2,35 meters
U19 boys	2,43 meters

6. Tournament jury

The tournament jury consists of 3 people who are handling any possible complaints and send offs. **Protests must be reported to the jury by the responsible coach within one hour after the objected match.** The fee for the protest is € 100, - and will be refunded in case the protest was accepted.

7. Subject to changes

The organizing committee is entitled to change the order of matches, the grouping, the times of the matches or the place of the match. The responsible team officials or coaches will be informed in time.

8. Insurance, Disclaimer & Theft

The participants are not insured! It is up to the responsible authorities and coaches of each team that their players and all the participants are insured for the days of the tournament during the United World Games. The organizers do not assume any kind of liability in case of illness, accidents or theft.

With his participation the athlete accepts the disclaimer of warranty for any kind of damage. No claims can be asserted against the organizing committee, the event sponsors, the community of Klagenfurt, real owners or their representatives regarding damage or injuries.

Every athlete has to make sure, that he is fully physically capable of participating without any medical objections.

For all players: Do not leave any valuable things and/or expensive clothing and/or shoes in the locker rooms.

9. Final remark

The organizers of the United World Games are at the understanding that each participant and team leader knows all the items as mentioned in these regulations.

IMPORTANT: In emergencies and during the night-time the emergency number 144 must be called. Please also note that if an injured athlete has to be transported to the hospital with an ambulance, a coach of the affected team must always go with him.
