## Regulations Ice stock sport

The United World Games Ice stock sport tournament will be played according to the official rules of the IFI – International Federation Icestocksport, except for the rules specifically mentioned in the following points:

### **Most Important Rule - FAIR PLAY**

It should be needless to say but we expect fair play from all teams! Please respect your opponents as well as the decisions of the referees and try to play as fair as possible.

### **1. Age Groups**

\*No minimum number of boys or girls required

## 2. Squad List & ID Checks

For **each participating team a squad list has to be submitted** to the Organizing Committee (via email to [office@unitedworldgames.com](mailto:office@unitedworldgames.com)), which will be checked, signed and handed out to the respective team representatives upon checking in in Klagenfurt. The coaches are requested to carry the signed squad list, as well as **player's licences or IDs of all athletes with them to all games**. Upon request, every player must be able to verify his or her identity by showing a valid photo ID card. In case of a suspected violation of deadlines or the use of an ineligible player, squad list and ID have to be checked in coordination with the referee/venue supervisor. A **violation results in an automatic defeat** for the concerned team.

Generally it is allowed for athletes to play in 2 separate teams, as long as they are not entering the same competition, yet they also have to appear on the respective squad lists of both teams (a player of the U14 tournament may for example also be a member of a team participating in the U16 competition and compete for both teams, provided the tournament schedule allows it).

Should participants enter one and the same competition with more than one team, they are forbidden to move players between these teams, **athletes may only appear on the squad list of ONE team per competition**.

## 3. Squad Size & Substitution of Players

One team consists of a maximum of 5 players: 4 starters and one substitution player. The substitution player mentioned in the squad list can be substituted after each game. Within a game, a substitution is only possible in the case of an injury.

## 4. Tournament Mode

**The tournament will be played as a 4 vs. 4 team competition.**

One game consists of **6 periods** called "Kehren" and lasts a maximum of **30 minutes**. If a game takes longer than 30 minutes, each team loses one game point. Each team will have a practice time which lasts at least 20 minutes.

The group stage will be played as a round robin.

**The ranking will be decided by points:**

Win	2 Points
Draw	1 Point
Loss	0 Points

The order of the teams will be in accordance with the criteria listed below:

1. Number of points.
2. The stock point difference of the games played against each other.
3. Head-to-Head

The first two teams of each group will advance into the semi-final.

**The detailed schedule will be sent to all teams and published on the homepage after the registration deadline.**

In case best ranked 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> (etc.) have to be determined, the ranking of said teams will be made by the following criteria:

- Total number of points/Number of games
- Stock point difference
- Decision by drawing lots (computerised random generator)

In case of a draw in the semi-final or final, an overtime of 2 "Kehren" will be played.

## 5. Walk over (w.o)

If a Team does not show up without any valid reason (decided by the tournament administration), it will result in an automatic loss of the game. A maximum of 5 minutes is given to teams which arrive late on side.

**Notice:** A walk over decision can only be announced after a communication with the tournament administration.

## 6. Sporting venues

It is only allowed to enter the sporting venues with proper indoor sports-shoes. It is not allowed to take food and beverages onto the sporting field.  
Exception: PET bottles

In all indoor areas, smoking is prohibited!

## 7. Material & Unified dress code

Male U16	P- or L-Ice Stocks (3,50-3,53kg or 3,70-3,73kg)
Female U16	P- or L-Ich Stocks (3,50-3,53kg or 3,70-3,73kg)
Mixed U14	E-Ice Stocks (2,73-2,78 kg) Max. yellow outsole (Shore 58)

**Notice:** If any material is needed, please give that information at the registration.

One team is only allowed to play in unified outer clothing as it would become too confusing for the referee and spectators.

## 8. Tournament Jury

The tournament jury consists of 3 people who handle any possible complaints and send offs.

## 9. Match Report

10 Minutes before each game, all coaches have to hand in the completed squad list to the organizing committee.

Every result must be signed by the team captain, otherwise the result will be invalid.

## 10. Insurance, Disclaimer & Theft

The participants are not insured! It is up to the responsible authorities and coaches of each team that their players and all the participants are insured for the days of the tournament during the United World Games. The organizers do not assume any kind of liability in case of illness, accidents or theft.

With his participation the athlete accepts the disclaimer of warranty for any kind of damage. No claims can be asserted against the organizing committee, the event sponsors, the community of Vienna, real owners or their representatives regarding damage or injuries.

Every athlete has to make sure, that he is fully physically capable of participating without any medical objections.

**For all players:** Do not leave any valuable things and/or expensive clothing and/or shoes in the locker rooms.

## 11. Disciplinary Remark

Severe offenses and brutal fouls will result in an automatic ban for the next game. In addition, the tournament direction will speak out a further suspension according to the severity of the offense. In case of a sending-off because of a brawl or insulting the referee, the concerned player will be disqualified for the whole remainder of the tournament.

Furthermore, the tournament direction reserves the right to suspend entire teams from the tournament, if they act disrespectful towards referees, officials or opponents, or misbehave themselves.

## 12. Final Remark

The organizers of the United World Games are at the understanding that each participant and team leader knows all the items as mentioned in these regulations.

**IMPORTANT: In emergencies and during the night-time the emergency number 144 must be called. Please also note that if an injured athlete has to be transported to the hospital with an ambulance, a coach of the affected team must always go with him.**
